To ensure privacy single gender accommodation may be provided in either single gender wards, or rooms within mixed wards. In exceptional circumstances in which a patient needs urgent or specialist care in areas such as Emergency Unit, Day Care Unit, Intensive Care Unit or recovery etc. mixing men and women may be unavoidable.

We will work to resolve such situations as quickly as possible and will keep patients and their families informed about our actions. If you have any concerns about privacy and dignity, please speak to the ward sister/charge nurse in the first instance or the matron for the area.
