

PROCEDURE

Cut and clip the varicose veins to the scrotum through a cut in the groin.

RISKS OF THIS PROCEDURE

There are some risks/ complications, which include:

- (a) The scrotum may swell up after surgery.
- (b) Bleeding may occur in the scrotum and this may need drainage.
- (c) Damage can occur to the blood supply of the testicle with possible damage to the testicle. As a result, the testicle may shrink and loose function.
- (d) Increased risk in obese people of wound infection, chest infection, heart and lung complications and thrombosis.
- (e) Increased risk in smokers of wound and chest infections, heart and lung complications and thrombosis.
